Suggestions for Upcoming IQAC Meeting:

Several key suggestions are discussed for consideration in the upcoming IQAC meetings:

1. Identification of Industry Mentors:

It is proposed to identify mentors from local industries in Saharanpur, particularly in areas such as wood carving, packaging, processing and wood crafting. This initiative aims to offer students exposure and practical experience by organizing visits to these industries and opening skill development certificate/ diploma programme.

2. Inviting Industry Mentors to IQAC Meetings:

It is suggested that industry mentors be invited to future IQAC meetings to share their experiences and provide guidance on enhancing student learning through industry exposure.

3. Student-Centric Programs:

Emphasis is placed on organizing programs that involve students and alumni, where alumni can share their success stories and provide insights to current students. The idea is to create a platform for students to learn from the real-life experiences of alumni.

4. Uploading Minutes on MSU Website:

It is recommended that the minutes of all IQAC meetings be uploaded on the MSU website to ensure transparency and keep all stakeholders informed about the discussions and decisions made.

5. Skill Development and Enhancement through Partnerships:

There is a suggestion to enhance skill development initiatives through strategic partnerships with industries, both local and global, to provide students with the skills necessary for the modern workforce.

6. Education Loan Support for Students Going Abroad:

It is suggested to seek support from the IQAC nominee from the banking sector to facilitate subsidized education loans for students pursuing studies abroad.

7. Promotion of Colleges for Timely NAAC Accreditation & Preparing the University Document for NAAC:

To suggest the colleges to promote the NAAC accreditation process within the stipulated timeframe and to outline documentation requirements, establish a data collection process and constitute a campus team to oversee the preparation of the NAAC report.

Other Discussions:

Further discussion focused on the implementation and follow-up actions required to materialize these suggestions.

The meeting concluded with a consensus to implement the suggested initiatives and to continue building upon the foundation set by the first meeting. The next meeting will be scheduled after further developments on the action points.
