Greetings from SOTTO – U. P. & the Department of Hospital Administration, SGPGIMS!

With regard to the subject & reference (enclosed, Annexure – 3) mentioned as above, this is to bring to your notice that the State Organ & Tissue Transplant Organization (SOTTO) for the state of Uttar Pradesh (U. P.) was established in the Sanjay Gandhi Post Graduate Institute of Medical Sciences (SGPGIMS), Lucknow under the National Organ Transplantation Program (NOTP) to formalize the system of removal, storage & transplantation of human organs & tissues in U. P., under pertinent mandate.

There is a wide gap between patients who need transplants & the organs that are available in India. An estimated 2 Lakh patients die of Liver Failure or Liver Cancer annually in India, about 10 - 15% of whom could have been saved with a timely Liver Transplant. Hence, about 25,000 - 30,000 Liver Transplants are needed annually in India. Similarly, about 5,00,000 persons suffer from Heart Failures annually, but only about 100 - 150 Heart Transplants are being performed every year in India. People from all over India are in immense need of Kidney, Liver, Heart, Cornea & Lung Transplantation.

SOTTO – U. P. has been mandated to take care of maintaining & disseminating Standard Operating Protocols (SOP's), Information, Education & Communication (IEC) materials, & conducting awareness seminars & pledge drives across the state of U. P., in order to augment the organ donor pool in the state & to thereby comply with the mandate of NOTP. Awareness Programs are being conducted by SOTTO – U. P. across different sections of society like Police, Teachers, Students, Lawyers, Bankers, Journalists & Trade Board, Nursing Staff, Housing societies, etc.

Indian Organ Donation Day on 3rd August, 2024

Dear Colleague

To further strengthen the healthcare systems, in order to facilitate organ donation and transplantation is among the top priorities of the Government of India. Organ donation is a noble act that offers hope and new lease of life to those suffering from the end stage organ failures. Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji has highlighted the importance of organ donation many times in his Mann Ki Baat programme.

One organ donor can save upto 8 to 9 lives. However, a huge gap exists between patients who require organ transplants and the organ donors that are available. In this context, Govt. of India has established **National Organ and Tissue Transplant Organization (NOTTO)**, an apex organization and similar organizations at regional state level to provide for an efficient and organized system of organ procurement and distribution in the country and to maintain a national registry of donors and recipients of organs and tissues.

NOTTO celebrates the Indian Organ Donation Day (IODD) every year to spread awareness about organ donation, dispel myths and misconceptions associated with organ donation and motivate and encourage the citizens of the country to donate organs and tissues after death, as well as to imbibe the value of organ donation in their lives.

This year, it has been decided to run public awareness campaign in the current year by the name of "Angdaan Jan Jagrukta Abhiyaan". As part of the campaign, Srd August 2024 will be celebrated as the Indian Organ Donation Day to commemorate the first deceased donor organ transplant, which was also the first Heart transplant done in the country, after promulgation of *"The Transplantation of Human Crgans Act"* on 8th July, 1994. The month of July 2024 (1st - 31st July) is hence organized as the **Organ Donation Month**, wherein many awareness activities have been planned.

The specific objectives of this year's campaign are:

- To reduce the demand for organ transplantation by promoting healthy lifestyles & wellness.
- To spread awareness about brain stem death, deceased organ donation, prevention & control of illegal practices related to organ transplantation.
- To bust myths and misconceptions related to organ donation & transplantation.

Step-by-Step Guide for Organ or Tissue Pledging

Who Can Pledge to Donate Organs?

- Any individual can voluntarily authorize the removal of any of their organs and/or tissues after her/his demise.
- The individual must be 18 years old or above.
- Refer to rule 5(4)(a), THOTA 1994 with The Transplantation of Human Organs and Tissues Rules, 2014. Pledge Form- 7.

Steps to Pledge:

1. Visit the NOTTO Website

- Go to NOTTO's website (<u>https://notto.abdm.gov.in/</u>) or scan the provided **QR Code**.
- 2. Log In
 - Use your Aadhaar card Number or Mobile Number (linked to Ayushman Bharat Health Account) to log in.

3. Complete Verification

 Verify your identity using the OTP sent to your Aadhaar Card-linked mobile number.

4. Fill in Details

- Enter your contact information.
- Specify the organs and/or tissues you wish to donate.

5. Submit the Form

- After filling in all necessary details, submit the form.
- Download a copy of the submitted pledge Form 7 for your records.

6. Right to Unpledge

 You have the right to unpledge at any point in time if you change your mind.

7. Share Your Pledge (Optional)

- If you wish, you can share your pledge on social media by tagging SOTTO- U. P. using the digital copy of the pledge form.
